

## Downloading and Installing Meditech Workstation 4.18

1. Click on link Meditech Workstation 4.18.
2. A window may appear asking: "Do you want to run or save this file?" Choose "Save."
3. When it asks you the location in which you want to download this file, select "Desktop."
4. Choose "Save."
5. Allow the download to run. Once it is finished, choose either "Run" or "Open."
6. It may pop up a security warning asking: "Are you sure you want to run this software?" Choose "Run."
7. The installation wizard will start.
8. Once it completes, you will see a window that reads: "Application is Up to Date." Choose: "OK."
9. Go to your Desktop, double-click "MEDITECH Remote Workstation 4."
10. You will need to add connections. Choose "Add."
11. It will ask for a name. Type: "A."
12. Choose "Telnet" for Connection Type.
13. Select "OK."
14. Leave the option for "Terminal Emulation" as "Magic."
15. In the Telnet Setup section, for Host Name/IP Address, type in "128.1.0.1"
16. Make sure that you leave "Use Proxy Server" UNCHECKED.
17. Select "OK."
18. You will now need to create three more connections the same way; except refer to the table below for what goes where.

	Connection Name	IP Address
1	B	128.1.0.2
2	C	128.1.0.4
3	D	128.1.0.5

19. Once these have been created, you should be able to choose "Connect," and it should begin "Checking for Abandoned Connections."

Some things to keep in mind:

In order to connect to Meditech in this fashion, you **MUST** be connected to the hospital through the Cisco VPN. If you do not have access to the VPN, please contact IT.

If you are in a dial-up only zone, then please refer to the Meditech Dial-Up Access and Setup.
